Players Code of Conduct

Under 8-12's Code of Conduct applies to all Registered Players

- All players must play and abide by the Rules and Regulations of AFL Victoria / South East Juniors and Narre Warren Junior Football Club.
- Never argue with an Official. If you disagree with a decision – discuss this matter with your Coach or team manager after the game. o Verbal abuse of Officials, other players or provoking an opponent is not acceptable. Control your temper.
- You are a part of a team so work equally hard for yourself and for your Team. Never speak badly to your team mates or put them down because they did something you don't agree with.
- Support your teammates. If they are upset, hurt or in need of support try to show them what a good a team mate you can be. Always tell an adult if the problem is a big one.
- Be a good sportsman. Congratulate all good plays whether they a part of your team, or the opposition team.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player. Do not make nasty comments because they may look, speak or do things a little differently.
- Co-operate with your Coach and be respectful. Remember – without them there would be no competition.
- Play to have “fun and enjoyment” and not just to please parents and coaches.
- No swearing at any time when you representing the club. This means not only when you are playing but also when you are out in the community wearing the clubs uniform.
- Be prepared to take responsibility for your actions.
- Remember if you are using social media – Facebook, Instagram, Tiktok, Snapchat etc, other people can see what you write. You are a member of NWJFC and therefore you cannot say anything bad about your players, coaches or any other members of the club that might make it look bad. Good sportsman always stay positive!
